**General.**

Unless by prior arrangement competitors are not permitted to enter the venue on Saturday the 19th of August, the only exception being those wanting to camp at the venue on the Saturday night. Should the entrance gate be locked when you arrive, the temporary code for the gate is 576, please lock the gate again once you have gained access into the venue. **Camping is allowed on the understanding each person has pre-registered by e-mail with the Clerk of the Course at [emyrhall@aol.com](mailto:emyrhall@aol.com) or by whatsapp on 07798 768184 and that each camper clears their rubbish away and **strictly no camp fires**; please only camp on the land adjacent to the service area - please don't camp in the service area. For overnight arrivals please proceed to the service area and camp on the farmland adjacent**

Due to space restrictions we are only permitting access for 1 support vehicle with each competing car into the venue. All other vehicles should park in the spectator car park.

Should there be any missing information on your entry form we would be grateful if you could please update your entry via the entry secretary ahead of the event at least 3 days in advance of the event – we will be hassling you!! **If you have not signed on electronically ahead of the event can we please ask you to do so a min of 3 days before the event via the event webpage.**

The venue will be open from 06.00am onwards on Sunday the 20th of August.

**Please observe and respect the Slow and Quiet boards in Bronaber village and the nearby farm leading to the Ranges. There have been complaints about speeding vehicles on the road by local residents can you please ask any support crews / spectators that you might know that are coming to the event to keep to a maximum speed limit of 20mph on approaching and leaving the venue. As it is the summer Holidays the Holiday Camp at Bronaber is full to capacity please respect the quiet boards; we rely on the goodwill of the holiday camp and their residents each year**

On arrival at the venue please unload your car and keep your trailer in the trailer park shown on the attached diagram. Proceed to Noise – your process card will be issued here, and the Noise Official will record your sound reading and will advise if you have passed or failed. On satisfactory completion proceed to scrutineering in the location shown on the attached diagram. Please have all the car documents with you at Scrutineering. On satisfactory completion of Scrutineering please collect your

pack from the Rally HQ – Please ensure that any sponsors decals are attached to your car ahead of starting the event

Your provisional start time will be in the start list within your rally pack, this may be subject to change on the morning of the event and a revised schedule may be placed on the official notice board at 09.00am to account for any changes in the entry.

Queries on results will be dealt with by handing your official query form to the Competitor Liaison Officer. Matthew Atkinson at [Rallies.info](http://Rallies.info) will be compiling the results these will be live on [Rallies.info](http://Rallies.info) on the EE Network – no other mobile phone network works at the venue unfortunately. There will be a screen in the service area that will also be displaying results

Officials, Marshals and Radio Cars; please accept our thanks and gratitude for your help, please report to Official's documentation, which opens at 07.15am. **The access gates to the venue will close at 8.30am prompt.** Can we please ask all marshals, radio cars and other officials to be at their posts by 8.30am.

Please use an impermeable ground sheet under your competing car at all times within the service area.

No fuel is available at the venue. Nia Roberts Catering will be in attendance. Rally Marketing will be present at the venue for the provision of competition numbers; these will not be provided by the organisers. John Davies, JD Tyres will be attending the event for any tyre requirements 07968 020546.

Please check your results during the day and submit any queries that you have on your return to service after each loop. This will help minimise any delays at the end of the event

The use of in-car cameras is authorised at the venue. The unit must be securely fixed and presented to and approved by the scrutineer at scrutineering.

At the end of the event, **NO** competitor or their service crew must attempt to retrieve their trailer until the closing car has completed the final stage. **This measure is for your safety and must be strictly adhered to.** For those unfortunate enough to retire during the first half of the rally, there will be the opportunity to leave the venue between stages 4 and 5 and stages 8 and 9.

The official notice board will be located within the signing on cabin.
